Full and Empty

Q. This is no longer poultry stuff.


A. Poultry or not, first, the formless spiritual archetypes, then, the form of material types, whether mineral, plant, animal, human to divinities.

- A. Now you know. Your first question did not apply.


Inter-triads of Reality Consciousness Life Form Birth Death Space Time






Mandala of Nature
