A house is as great as the design of its architecture. The architecture of a house is as great as the library around which the house is built. Definitions

Science is the search for knowledge. It is a voyage into the unknown; from hypothesis, to investigation, verification and, finally, the formulation of a principle or law of nature. The study of science disciplines our power to search, behold and

apply the whole truth.

Religion is the search for goodness. Discovery is from error to the ethical, from selfishness to altruism, or from the imperfect to the perfect. Art is the search for beauty. Art is our handmaiden, from chaos to order, from intellectuality to intelligence, from the ideal to the virtuous. For the basis of art is order. The basis of order is intelligence. The basis of intelligence is in the virtues and ideals. And the basis of the virtues and ideals is in the essential nature of our own humanity. True art awakens the intuition. Its study and appreciation refines human character.

The Physical is of the nature of the material universe. Its density ranges from the solid, liquid, gaseous, thermodynamic, electromagnetic, chemical, onto the nuclear state of matter.

The Emotional is of the nature of desire. There is no emotion that cannot be directly or indirectly traced back to a desire. When one is emotionally happy, a desire has been fulfilled. Just as when one is emotionally unhappy, a desire has been denied. Thus the control of the emotions is in the conquest of desire. Our desire for material objects is vanquished by the aspiration

for the spiritual virtues.

The Mental is twofold in nature. Its lower nature thrives on ideas. Its higher nature dwells on the ideals. It is the collective accumulation of ideas that jells into an illusory separate selfish self or a bogus ego. Know that the aggravated problems of communication are in direct proportion to the size of the egos communicating with each other. When ideas are in complete accord with the spiritual ideals, the mental nature is made whole and healing. Competition resolves into cooperation. Thus, there is wholeness or holiness.

The Spiritual is of the nature of the Universal Spirit. The divine and the human, function as one. In this unity, the One is without a Second. And the Dharma or our true nature is fulfilled.

The Summa Sophia or Highest Wisdom of the Dharma

is in the integrative unity of art, philosophy, religion and science. The wholeness is the holiness.
